This position is responsible for the enforcement of Municipal Bylaws and select Provincial Statutes. The Community Peace Officer will also conduct public safety and education activities and provide support and assistance to other Municipal Departments.

The successful candidate will demonstrate proven time management, communication, interpersonal and leadership skills. Knowledge and experience in rural bylaw enforcement, provincial legislation, commercial vehicle weight enforcement and traffic enforcement is required. A valid Class 5 Operator's License is required. Preference will be given to applicants with a diploma or certificate from a recognized Law Enforcement Program and/or several years of related experience in Law Enforcement, preferably in a Municipal Government environment. All Applicants interviewed must submit a Criminal Record and background security check.

The successful candidate will possess or be eligible to obtain an appointment as a Community Peace Officer through Alberta Justice and successfully complete the P.A.R.E. physical testing within the prescribed time and be valid at time of employment. The individual will be working forty (40) hours per week and must be willing to work shift work, weekends and statutory holidays.
